#### **POSITION SUMMARY**

Using collaborative skills and knowledge of TOPCUs products and relevant regulations, the Operations Supervisor provides supervision and oversight to Audit, Plastics and Processor functions. Situations can move quickly from low stress to high stress and can require flexible hours.

# **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS**

- Provide direction and leadership to Processor, Audit and Plastics Specialist teams with emphasis on extraordinary internal member service, achieving department goals, and team work
- Effectively create and maintain accurate TOPCU procedures for audit and other checklists for direct reports
- Provide requested documents for audit and exam reports
- Coordinating the implementation of new products and services within the Processing department
- Monitors all operations support activity to ensure compliance with credit union standards, policies, procedures and all applicable state and federal regulations
- Manage direct reports including setting schedules, approving time, evaluating performance, conduct coaching and mentoring
- Collaborate with HR to ensure department employment needs are met; responsible for hiring decisions and coordinating with HR regarding disciplinaries and terminations
- Prepare and present performance reviews for direct reports
- Act as the subject matter expert for direct reports and oversee departmental projects
- Perform supervisor overrides for other staff as outlined in "Limited Supervisor Override Authority"
- Monitor and/or audit reports processed by direct reports
- Monitor and/or complete daily imaging
- Assist team members with questions and concerns and provide necessary/requested information
- Collaborate with HR to determine additional training needs for direct reports
- Ensure files for consumer, mortgage and business loans are accurately and properly closed
- Set up ACH payments, funds transfers, and direct deposit as applicable
- Confirm balance disbursed check totals and teller check totals for department are processed daily
- Provide notary service as applicable
- Understand compliance issues, adhere to regulations, and attend training as related to the position
- Perform other duties as assigned
- Mandatory compliance of all regulations including BSA/AML, adhere to TOPCU procedures and accurately complete applicable forms in a timely manner
  - o Maintain awareness of and report suspicious activity
  - Complete annual BSA training
  - Notify immediate supervisor of any substantive
